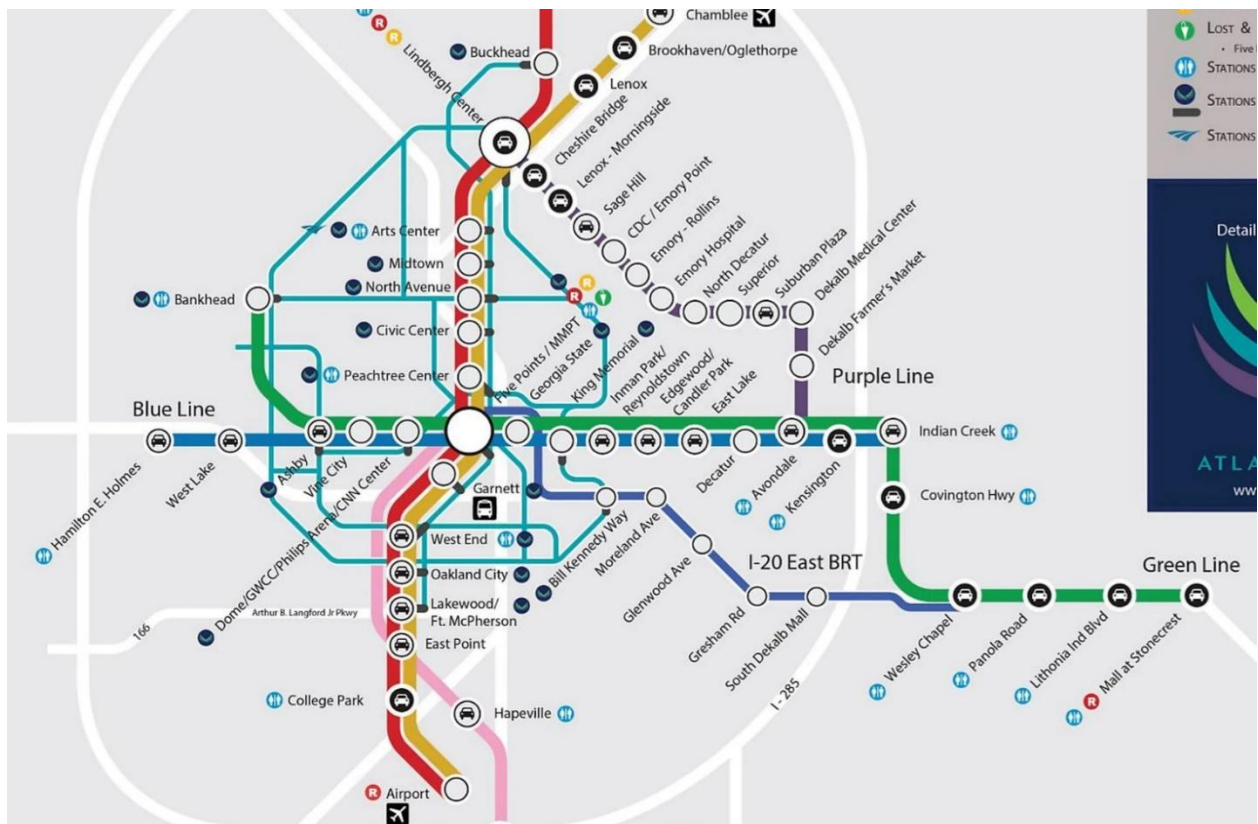
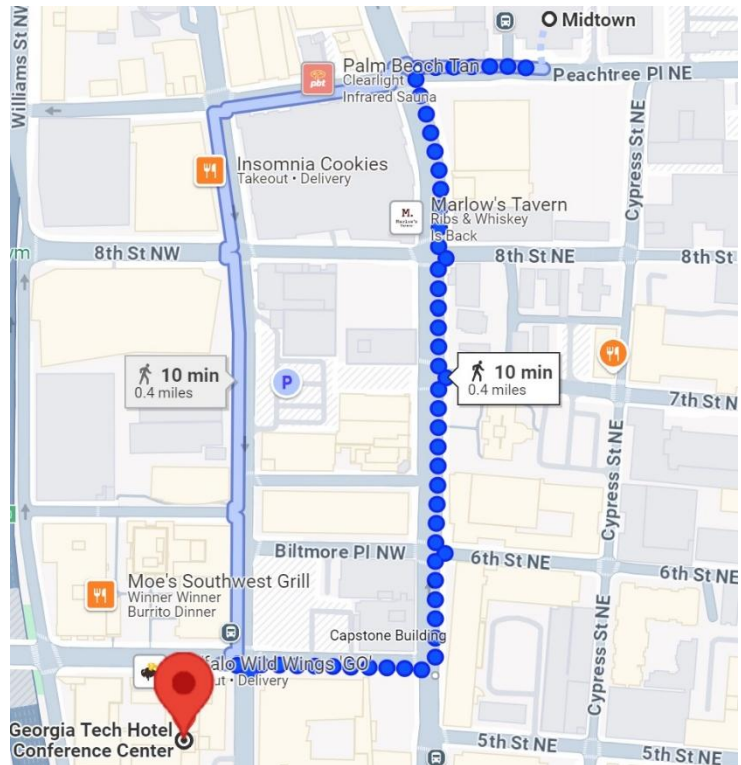


From ATL Airport to GT Hotel & Global Conference Center

You can take Marta (either Red or Gold lines) at Atlanta Hartsfield Airport (map attached). You can get off at the Midtown Station. By walking, it takes ~10 minutes from the Midtown Station to the GT Hotel (0.4 miles).

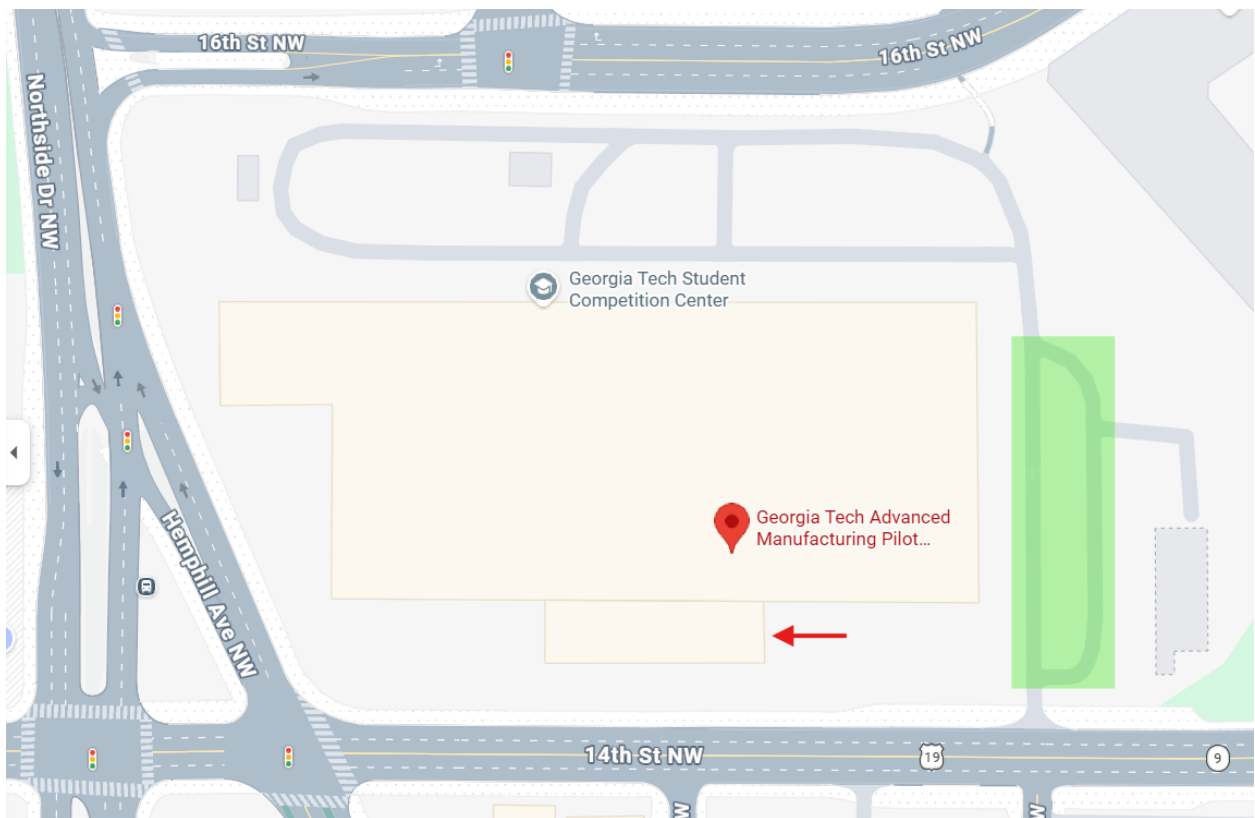




Map/Direction to Advanced Manufacturing Pilot Facility (AMPF)

555 14th Street, Atlanta, GA 30332

- Please make sure to park in the large parking lot (555 14th Street) **not** the 575 14th street parking
- Passenger vans will be operating to shuttle attendees from Georgia Tech Hotel & Conference Center to AMPF and back
- Please park in Lot C on the east side of the building (highlighted green). Parking is free!
- Enter the building through the double doors off Lot B (indicated by red arrow).
